

## **Implementing the President's Management Agenda on e-Government Roundtable Discussion 1**

### Summary:

There are continuing challenges with implementation of e-Gov initiatives as it relates to the Bureau of Land Management's mission. Bureau leadership is evaluating these challenges and the associated costs in the larger scope of the Bureau's initiatives to better serve the public.

### Synopsis of Discussion:

With respect to implementation of e-Gov initiatives, DOI and BLM have made progress in certain areas. We measure this progress in the context of the President's Management Agenda (PMA). In the PMA, OMB rates departments and agencies against a balanced scorecard, and those rating factors are what DOI and BLM use to organize our efforts.
